75th ANNIVERSARY

The year 2000 marks Hensman's 75th nded to 8 courts.

By November of that year the approach had been extended as indicated in the following minute "...whereas the original decision to lay courts on the reserve at the corner of Coode and Hensman Streets allowed for only 2 courts, this provision be


TENNIS ENDURANCE TIPS
