My thanks go to Denise Dalton, James Williams and their assistants for the time and effort they gave to this event. We have been disappointed with the declining number of entries over the last few years. We may need to consider new formats and timespans. If you have any constructive ideas I would appreciate receiving them.

In closing this final edition of the Herald for the summer season, I look forward to seeing as many members as possible at both the Annual General Meeting and the Annual Dinner.
