

### **BUMPING BOARD - MAY 1997**

Ken McIntosh - Men's Captain Debbie Napier - Ladies' Captain


The various bumping boards have been reassessed based on results of the 1997 Club Championships and, to a lesser extent, the performances over the last year's Summer Tennis League results. Advice has been sought from several other members when determining player ranking. The bumping board listed was approved by the Board of Management on 12 May 1997.

Some Club Championship results can be interpreted a number of different ways and do not, for example, definitively establish how far a person should be promoted. However, after discussion with various Club members and the Board, we believe we have listed a FAIR set of Club rankings.

A list has been made of players whose ranking is provisional and whose positions need to be confirmed by further matches. These players must play grading matches immediately after 1 October 1997 to confirm or establish their correct position. The 1997/98 Club Captains will advise all players of their grading matches by 15 September 1997. Players may issue their own Challenge Matches after 1 October. Please refer to the Club's "Challenge, Grading and Bumping Board Rules".

The overall aim of the Bumping Board is to have all players playing in the correct order and in the correct team for the 1997/98 Summer Tennis League season. Grading and challange matches in October will achieve this. Therefore, all players must ensure they are prepared for tennis by 1 October.
