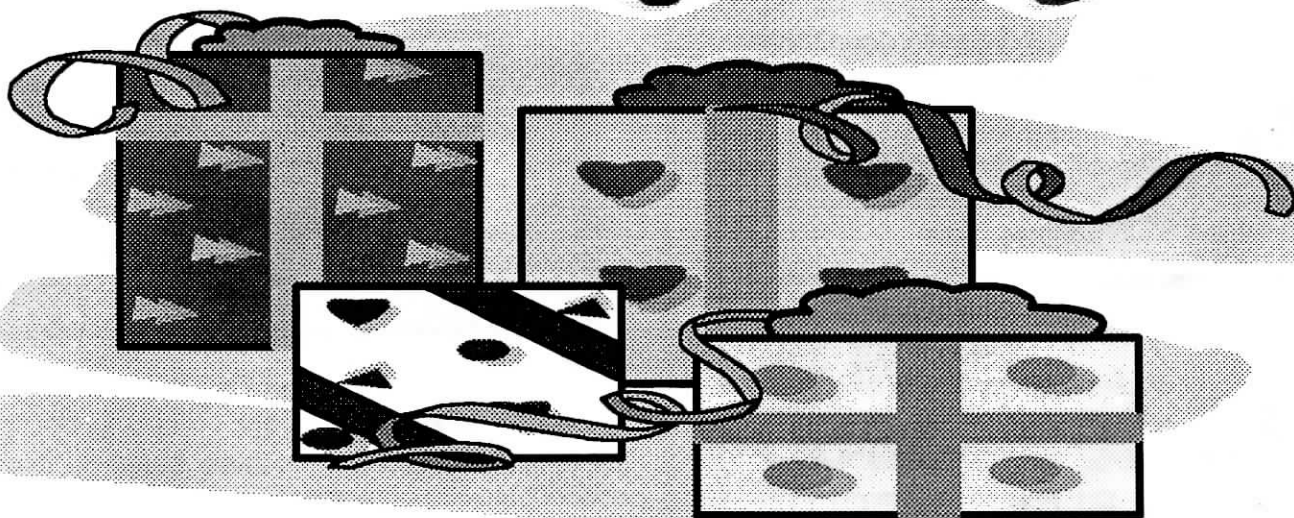

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

CAPTAIN'S CORNER

SUMMER TENNIS LEAGUE

At the time of writing Hensman's 26 tennis league teams have completed 40% of their matches. Most teams have enjoyed success with the Men's State League having 2 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses. The Sunday Ladies Veterans team is Hensman's only undefeated team at this stage. Well done to Margaret, June, Sue, Margaret, Pat, Lois and Pam. Keep it up.

The following teams have only recorded 1 loss and are looking good for the finals in March

- MENS Sunday Division 8, Veterans Divisions 5 and 6

- LADIES Mid-week Grass Court Over 60

Several teams are yet to break the ice but they all have been extremely competitive and it won't be long before they join the winners' circle.

If members wish to follow the progress of the teams, results are recorded each week on the Notice Board at the club house (east wall). One (1) Gold star is awarded each week to the team that bribes the Men's Captain with the first drink. Any team caught putting up extra gold stars for themselves (as 1 team has already done) will lose all their gold stars (even if you are the President).

During December 14 members are participating in a series of Tennis League coaching sessions with Keith Begley and are gaining a better appreciation of 'Tennis tactics' and improving their shot selection.

Tennis League - Home Teams

Due to the low numbers of members participating in social tennis on Sundays, the Board has arranged for the Ladies Vets and Mens Vets Div 5 teams to play their home

matches at Hensman Park rather than Nedlands from December 11. The Board will continue to look at the usage of courts on Saturdays and Sundays and if courts are continually vacant, they will consider bringing more teams back to Hensman Park for home matches.

Balls

ALORA balls have been tried out successfully on both hard and grass courts. Their performance has been comparable with Slazenger balls and since they are much cheaper (\$21.50 compared with \$39 per dozen), they will be used much more regularly for social play. Members feedback on these balls will be appreciated.

BUMPING BOARD

The Bumping Boards for all categories of players have been displayed at the club for some time. Remember if any player wants to improve his/her position he/she should start issuing challenges to higher players as per the Bumping Board Rules. Any queries please see Ken McIntosh. The Tennis League Selection Committee encourages players who wish to challenge. Fair competition can only keep up the club's playing strength.

Note however, the Committee has determined that Tennis League teams should not change as from February 3, 1995. Therefore if you wish to play in a higher position or team, you need to start challenging now.

No Play on Grass Courts on Fridays

Please observe the signs at the club re when courts can be played on by members. It is club policy that there be *no play on grass courts on Fridays* except for Junior Coaching.

KNOW YOUR BOARD MEMBER

Randy Raux

Although it took him until 1984 to join Hensman Park, current Social Director, **RANDY RAUX**, was probably always destined to become a member. His introduction to tennis occurred while in his senior years at Armadale High School where long time Hensman Park coach, Don Harris, was in charge of tennis development. This led to a period of private coaching at Don's instigation.

Several years later as an employee of the ANZ Bank, Randy found himself part of a branch managed by Frank Thomas. Frank even succeeded in getting him to the courts as a visitor but transport difficulties to and from his Cannington home discouraged Randy from taking up membership at the time. Finally when he and Norm moved into Melville Parade, he accepted the invitation of neighbours, Fay and Ross Totterdell, to revisit Hensman and his membership was sealed. (Norm followed his example the following year.)

From that moment Randy became a vital part of the club, both on and off the court. He was immediately inveigled onto the social committee which he went on to chair for some six years. After a short 'retirement' he has returned to the fold as Social Director for 1994/95.

On the court he has also made his mark. A regular pennant player he has featured in a number of finals - without actually winning any (!) - but has picked up trophies in several club handicap events, as well as a string of open and veteran titles throughout the State ranging from Albany, Wickiepin, York, Beverly to Geraldton.

His first taste of competitive tennis came in the Catholic Association as a member of Queens Park in the early 1960's, followed by a stint in Southern Suburbs with the Cockburn club while working for the bank at Rockingham, before returning to Queens Park where he filled a spot in their top team in the South Suburban Association. During this period he also represented WA in 3 Catholic Association Australian Carnivals, 2 of which were won by the WA side.

Randy was born in Colombo, Ceylon (as it was then known) and moved to Perth with his parents and sister, Sharon, in 1958 as a primary school student. Initially he stayed with an uncle and aunt in Inglewood before settling in Cannington. This was a very major step for the whole family but one which none of them ever regretted. It was certainly a decision which proved beneficial to Hensman.

We gained a member who has made an outstanding contribution in a relatively short time, a contribution which was recognised formally in 1991 when Randy received the prestigious 'Member of the Year Award'.



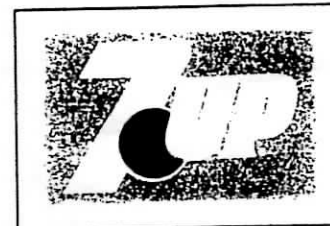

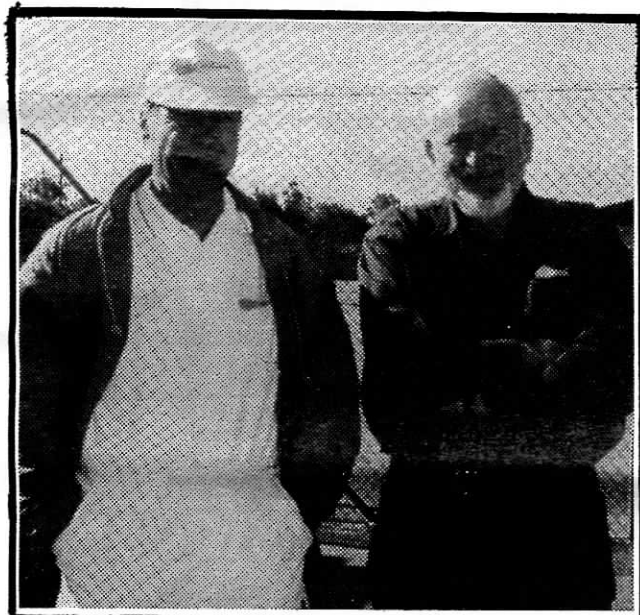
