Our Junior Girls won their shields in 1948/49 and 1949/50, the team including Pat Cunningham, Una Prater and Mary Blacklock (now Hicks).

It wasn't until 1951/52 that Hensman won the coveted Mens A Grade (now State League). Our first winning team comprised Clive Wilderspin, John Blacklock, Brian Ford, Alan Hicks, Arthur Marshall and Bob Spark.
